Serves as a senior architecture specialist and provides expert advice, opinions, and recommendations on architecture issues. Decisions, recommendations, and conclusions are considered authoritative and have considerable influence and impact on the overall engineering and design activities. Also acts as the military program manager coordinating all aspects of the district's military program. Work performed includes participating in the formulation/recommendations of Branch-wide program plans, policies, and procedure factors such as public relations, public policy stances, economic impact, effect on other organizations, etc. Performs other duties as assigned.

- Specialized Experience: To qualify at the GS-13 level, applicants must possess 1 year of specialized experience at the GS-12 level. Specialized experience is defined as experience in program coordination involving installation oriented architectural and engineering design technical support service efforts through project initiation, planning, assigning, scheduling, funding, execution, delivery and close out of military projects, or other work that is typically in or related to the work of the position to be filled.
- GS-12 and above: Bachelor's degree directly related to this occupation and 1 year of experience directly related to this occupation equivalent to the next lower grade level.
- The experience described in your resume will be evaluated as related to the qualifications, knowledge, skills and abilities required for this job.
- Applicants who have held a General Schedule (GS) position within the last 52 weeks must meet the Time in Grade Restriction.
- Must have 52 weeks of Federal service at the next lower grade (or equivalent).
- Only degrees from an accredited college or university recognized by the Department of Education are acceptable to meet positive education requirements or to substitute education for experience.
