Duties: Prepares plans and specifications for construction contracts of levee and channels with related features. Project work involves design of multiple related features, such as borrow areas, berms, road crossings, compaction, provision for drainage over relatively large areas, improvements to major drainage systems, clearing, relocation of public utilities and roads, culverts, and extensive right-of-way requirements. Assures designs comply with environmental laws and regulations. Assembles and analyzes information to determine adequate design sections, quantities of excavation, spoil requirements and right-of-way limits. Makes field reconnaissance to ascertain conditions and assess local drainage requirements not otherwise considered. Makes comparative studies of alternate designs and alignments and recommends most feasible plans. Prepares clearing, embankment and excavation quantities and rights-of-way requirements for proposed project studies for other district elements.
