 This solicitation is for Cairo Levee Reach, Levee Grade Raise and Resurfacing, Alexander County, IL, Mississippi River Levees - Construction, scheduled to open 04 April 2002, at 2:30 p.m., is amended as follows:

1. SECTION 00010, Pages 3 and 4, SUPPLIES OR SERVICES AND PRICES/COSTS, is deleted in its entirety and the attached pages 3 and 4 are substituted therefor.
2. SECTION 00800, Page 00800-TOC-1, Para No. 1.10. Delete "Quantity Surveys - Alternate I" and substitute "Not Used".

3. SECTION 00800, Page 00800-4, Paragraph 1.10. Delete paragraph in its entirety and substitute “1.10. NOT USED.”

4. SECTION 00800, Page 00800-15, Paragraph 1.32. Delete paragraph in its entirety and substitute the following:

“1.32. SUBMITTALS. See Section 02546 for review and approval of submittals.”

5. SECTION 00800, Submittal Register. Delete the Submittal Registers and Instructions.

6. SECTION 01025, Page 01025-2, paragraph 1.3.2. Add the following subparagraph (3):

“(3) “Traffic Control”

a. Payment will be made for costs associated with operations necessary for providing four Type III barricades and two road signs as specified in Section 01452, paragraph 1.3.

b. Unit of measure, lump sum: LS.”

7. SECTION 01025, Page 01025-3, paragraph 1.4.2. Delete paragraph 1.4.2 in its entirety and substitute the following:

“1.4.2 Unit Price Items

(1) “Aggregate Surfacing”

a. Measurement

If the materials are delivered by railroad, weights as acceptable to the railroad for freight charge purposes will be accepted as measurement of the materials. Copies of freight bills or certifications of weights acceptable to the railroad for freight charge purposes shall be furnished. If not delivered by railroad, but delivered by truck, the materials will be measured for payment, in the presence of a Government Inspector unless waived by the Contracting Officer, by being weighed on approved, accurately calibrated scales furnished by and at the expense of the Contractor. Weight certificates furnished by a public weighmaster where available will be acceptable in lieu of such procedure when authorized by the Contracting Officer. Individual weight tickets shall be furnished the Government Inspector at the time of delivery.

b. Payment

Payment for aggregate surfacing will be made at the applicable contract unit price per ton for “Aggregate Surfacing”, which price and payment shall include all costs of preparing subgrade; furnishing, transporting, placing, dressing and compacting material; maintaining and final dressing of surfacing; and performing all other operations incidental to the work specified in SECTION 02546.

c. Unit of measure, ton: TN”

8. SECTION 01452. Delete SECTION 01452 in its entirety and substitute the attached SECTION 01452.

9. SECTION 02546, Page 02546-1, paragraph 1.1. Add the following to the beginning of paragraph 1.1:

“The purpose of this project is to raise the grade of the levee by the placing of aggregate material. This will be accomplished by raising the crown of the levee to the elevations, dimensions, and thicknesses shown on the drawings.”

10. SECTION 02546, Page 02546 –4, paragraph 3.3. Delete the first sentence and substitute “The subgrade shall be symmetrical as indicated on the drawings so that drainage will occur each way from the centerline.”

11. SECTION 02546, Page 02546-4, paragraph 3.3. Add the following to the end of paragraph 3.3:

“In the vicinity of Mile 14, where the road separates from the levee, the grade raise shall continue on the levee rather than the road.”

12. SECTION 02546, Page 02546-5, paragraph 3.4. Add the following subparagraph 3.4. (3):

“(3) In the vicinity of Mile 14, where the road separates from the levee, the grade raise shall continue on the levee rather than the road.”

13. In the Bookmark section of the Specifications, under Division 2 Site Work, delete 02946 and substitute 02546.

Drawing 1. Add the following note:

“Two “NO THRU TRAFFIC” signs and four Type III Barricades to be erected at locations designated by the Contracting Officer.”

Drawing 4. Change the Approximate Aggregate Quantity from 46,000 CU. YDS. to 68,000 tons.

bid schedule.

PROJECT SIGNS, BARRICADES, AND TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNS

PART 1 GENERAL

1.1 SCOPE

The work covered by this section consists of furnishing, erecting, maintaining, and removing project signs and furnishing, erecting, and maintaining permanent traffic control signs and barricades.

1.2 PROJECT SIGNS

The Contractor shall furnish, erect, and maintain two single faced project signs, at the specific location designated by the Contracting Officer. The signs shall be constructed of 3/4-inch A-C exterior plywood or 22 gage metal, mounted on a substantial framework of 2-inch material. Size, lettering, color and paint shall conform to the details shown on the drawing "Temporary Project Sign" included at the end of this section. Upon request, the Government will furnish without cost to the Contractor two decals of the Engineer Castle. The sign shall be erected as soon as practicable, but not later than 15 calendar days after the date established for commencement of work. The sign shall be removed upon completion of all other construction work under the contract and will become the property of the Contractor.

1.3 BARRICADES AND TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNS

Barricades and traffic control signs shall be those as needed or required and shall conform to the "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways," Current Edition. The Contractor shall place 4 (four) permanent Type III barricades using galvanized U-Channel posts at abandoned railroad openings as indicated on the drawings at specific locations designated by the Contracting Officer. Two traffic control signs mounted on galvanized U-Channel posts shall read "No Thru Traffic" and shall be placed as indicated on the drawings at the specific locations designated by the Contracting Officer. All signage and barricades shall be affixed to metal backing.

1.4. PAYMENT

No separate payment will be made for erecting, maintaining and removing project signs and all costs in connection therewith will be considered an incidental obligation of the Contractor. The permanent Type III barricade signs and traffic control signs shall be paid for in one lump sum as specified in paragraph 1.3 above.
