OPTIONAL ADDITIONAL INFORMATION SUPPORTING NJD (e.g., discussion may include information reviewed to assess potential navigation or interstate commerce connections - 1 to 3 paragraphs): This site contains an approximately 0.70 acre tract of cutover timber. Scattered within the site are small pockets of wetlands. At the time of the inspection the wetlands were dry. These wetlands would be most apparent during early spring months. It is dominated by herbaceous vegetation (including sedges and rushes). No distinct hydrologic connection was observed between this wetland.
