Pursuant to the Code of Federal Regulations 33 CFR 325.1(a) (8), notice is hereby given of decisions reached during the period of January 1, 2011, through December 1, 2011, by the Memphis District, U. S. Army Corps of Engineers, on applications for standard permits under Section 10 of the Rivers and Harbors Act of 1899 and Section 404 of the Clean Water Act.

MVM-2009-093 [JME]  Mr. John Conroy Riverfront Development Corporation 22 North Front Street, Suite 960 Memphis, Tennessee 38103	A Section 10 and 404 permit was issued to restore and improve to the Memphis Cobblestone Landing by stabilizing the western edge of the cobblestones, removing above-ground utilities, providing interpretative signage addressing the historical significance of the cobblestones and improving public accessibility to the Wolf River Harbor by adding walkways, staircases, and a boat ramp. This project is located in the City of Memphis, Shelby County, TN
MVM-2010-308 [RDM]  Mr. Jim Byrd 119 Lagrue Sherwood, Arkansas 72120	A Section 404 permit was issued to create a 3.0-acre recreation pond and the construction of a levee. The creation of this pond will result in impacts to approximately 2.5-acres of floodplain terrace depressional wetlands. The project is located in White County, Arkansas.
MVM-2010-472 [ECG]  Mr. Greg Novotny Manley Brothers, LLC 200 Benton Street Valley Park, Missouri 63088	A Section 10/404 permit was issued to construct one open pile lattice foundation for support of the outbound conveyor and spout, up to three intermediate conveyor bents and five to six typical mooring dolphins, one open pile structure supporting the outbound conveyor and spout and three intermediate conveyor support bents. The project is located in Lauderdale County, TN.
MVM-2010-450 [RSA]  Mr. Benjamin Ashcraft 7475 Highway 51 Broseley, Missouri 63932	A Section 404 permit was issued to place fill material into a 1.9-acre farmed wetland for increased irrigation efficiency and agricultural production. The project is located in Butler County MO.
MVM-2010-531 [JME]  Mr. Shawn Billings Continental Construction 5646 Shelby Oaks Drive Memphis, Tennessee 38134	A Section 10 permit was issued to construct a grain terminal located north of Jack Carley Causeway on the left-descending bank of the Mississippi River at approximate River Mile 734 in Memphis, Shelby County, TN.



Box 13427 Memphis, Tennessee 38113-0427	A Section 10 permit was issued to increase mooring capacity by adding 24 additional barge sites at one site and 12 additional barge sites at another site. The project is located on the Mississippi River in Crittenden County, AR.
MVM-2011-078 [RDM]  Mr. Kenny Falwell Eagle Lake Farms 2800 Lynn Street Newport, Arkansas 72112	A Section 404 permit was issued to install a re-lift pump in the White River at approximate river mile 251 for the purpose of irrigating rice crops near the city of Newport, Jackson County, AR.
MVM-2008-299 [JKB]  Mr. Chris Lambert Lambert Engineering and Surveying 125 North New Madrid Street Sikeston, Missouri 63801	A Section 10 permit was issued to construct two mooring dolphins for traffic barge containment and commercial transportation in New Madrid County, MO.
MVM-2011-110 [JRC]  Mr. Garry Wilson 64 Holly Road Boaz, Kentucky 42027	A Section 404 permit was issued to to mechanically clear 0.77 acres of wooded wetlands for agricultural production. The project is located in Graves County, KY.
MVM-2011-245 [JME]  Ms. Melanie Bumpus Natural Resource Office, Permit Section TN Department of Transportation Suite 900, James K. Polk Building Nashville, Tennessee 37243-0334	A Section 404 permit was issued to widen State Route 104 from west of State Route 188 to Milligan Gumwoods Road in Gibson County, TN.

McCrory Memphis & Shelby Co Port Authority 1115 Riverside Boulevard Memphis, Tennessee 38106-2504	A Section 10/404 permit was modified to allow a one-time excavation of approximately 5,000 cubic yards of material from the mouth of the Pidgeon Industrial Harbor. The excavated material was to be placed on a barge and disposed of on an upland site. The project is located in Shelby County TN.

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MVM-2007-210 [JRC]  Mr. Roy C. Collins III Kentucky Transportation Cabinet 200 Mero Street Frankfort, Kentucky 40622	A Section 404 permit was modified to allow the use of the Cotton Riley Advanced Mitigation Site instead of the onsite mitigation plan approved in the permit. The proposed project is located just south of the City of Mayfield in Graves County, KY.
MVM-2011-340 [JKB]  Mr. Jeff Sawyer Pollution Management, Inc. 3512 South Shackelford Little Rock, Arkansas 72205	A Section 10 permit was modified to allow the operating parameters and towers of an existing overhead transmission line that crosses the St. Francis River in Greene and Craighead Counties, AR to be increased.
MVM-2010-568 JM	A Section 404 permit was issued to fill wetlands associated with the replacement of a bridge over Des Arc Bayou near the City of Romance on County Road 26 in White County, AR.
MVM-2011-025-RCW	A Section 10 and 404 permit was issued to add two new 72-inch diameter dolphins at River Mile 644.6 in the Mississippi River in Phillips County, AR.
MVM-2011-345 JM  Mr. Lynn Malbrough Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department P.O. Box 2261 Little Rock Arkansas 72203	A Section 404 permit was issued to fill wetlands associated with the construction of 10.4 miles road to by-pass the City of Paragould, AR in Greene County AR.
