**Responsibilities/Duties:** Incumbent serves as a Deckhand on the M/V George C. Grugett and performs a variety of work involved in the operation, maintenance, and repair of the deck and general housekeeping functions on dredges, towboats, barges, or other floating plant vessels.

**Schedule:** During the towing season, typically May through November, this position works a 12 days on/2 days off schedule. This position works a 12-hour shift and may rotate between day and night shifts. During the non-operating season, the crew works day shift only, with the vessel based at Ensley Engineer Yard, Memphis, TN, on either a 5-day/8-hour or 4-day/10-hr schedule. During the operating season, the vessel will work in widespread locations in the Mississippi River and Inland waters. This is a permanent seasonal position; seasonal workers are normally placed in non-pay status (laid off) for part of the non-construction season.
