Responsibilities/Duties:

Performs manual tasks in the handling of lines to moor floating plant and to make and break tows in a berthing area consisting of about three miles of riverfront, with mooring facilities such as mooring barges, dolphins, pilings, deadmen etc.

Typically performs the following:

1. Performs harbor work including handling lines to secure plant to mooring string-out barges. Ties various sailor knots in making lines fast and threads and uses block and tackle in sparring out plant. Moves and makes gangplanks and walkways secure.
2. Transports materials and supplies to boats and barges. Pumps out barges by operation of portable gasoline and electric pumps.
3. Serves as a deckhand on harbor and river vessels.
4. Operates equipment including lawn mowers, forklifts, and tractors.
5. Assists welders, mechanics, equipment operators, and other trade specialists transporting and handling job tools, equipment and supplies; and providing safety spotting.
6. Performs work on drydocks to include assisting with setting blocks and docking/undocking vessels.

Performs other duties as assigned.

Conditions of Employment & Notes:

- May be subject to assignment on other phases of productive work, which may include travel from their permanent duty station, depending on (1) needs of the organization; (2) individual ability; (3) requirements for utilization of personnel to a desirable degree; and (4) the need for new and additional experience as required by operations. Is also subject to assignment where needed during emergencies.
- This position has a Temporary Duty (TDY) or business travel requirement of up to 50%, which may include staying aboard assigned vessel.

- This position is covered by the DOT rules and USACE ER 690-1-1218. May be subject to random alcohol and drug testing on an unannounced basis. Incumbent is required to sign a DA Form 7412, “Condition of Employment for Certain Civilian Positions Identified Safety-Sensitive Under The Department of Transportation, Federal Highway Administration Rules on Drug and Alcohol Testing” or a Memorandum of Understanding.
