# Dredge and Floating Plant locations in Memphis District and status as of Nov. 02, 2012

**USACE Dredge Hurley:** Currently dredging at Ensley Bar, mile 726 LMR.

**Contract Dredge Venture:** Is currently at Wolf River Harbor, Memphis, mile 736 LMR. Will later move to McKellar Lake for more work there.

**Contract Dredge Pontchartrain:** Has completed its portion of Corps of Engineers dredging at McKellar Lake.

Riverbank Stabilization Mat Sinking Unit: Bougere, La., mile 328.4 LMR.

### Funding status as of Nov. 02, 2012

Mainstem Mississippi River channel dredging: \$21.4 million received, \$17.6 million obligated.

Harbor dredging: \$17.0 million received, \$15.9 million obligated.

### **Additional information**

**General Conditions:** The effects of Hurricane Sandy reached the confluence area sooner than originally forecasted. This morning the Cairo stage was 15.8 feet, an increase of 4.0 feet over the last 24 hours. Cairo is predicted to rise to 22.5 feet by Wednesday. At Memphis, the river stage was minus 5.3 feet today and will quickly rise about 6.5 feet to a reading of 1.2 feet on the Memphis gage by Wednesday. Showers/thunderstorms are predicted for the region beginning tomorrow evening continuing into Monday with rainfall amounts up to 3/4" predicted.
