DESCRIPTION OF WORK: The applicant has re-applied for a permit to install an irrigation pump in the White River to pump surface water to irrigate crops during the growing season. The pump will draw approximately 5000 gallons of water per minute. This permit was previously issued; however, the project was not constructed prior to expiration of the permit. PURPOSE: As stated by the applicant, the purpose is crop irrigation.
